A free, overnight bereavement camp for youth who are grieving the death of a significant person in their lives. Children and teens ages 6 to 17 attend a weekend camp experience that combines grief education and emotional support with fun, traditional camp activities.

A free, overnight bereavement camp to support families who have experienced the death of someone significant in their lives. Families explore their grief, learn coping skills, and make connections with other families through camp activities.

Mourning in Motion/Art from Our Heart

One-day grief support event for youth to express their thoughts and emotions through movement or art.
